Goal: *To Prepare Members for Spiritual Revival*

- Objectives:**
- 1. To have each member pray each day for a specific prayer focus.*
 - 2. To have each member pray with a prayer partner at least once per week.*
 - 3. To have members pray for at least three persons they want to see give their lives to Jesus.*
 - 4. To have testimonies each Sabbath by selecting a member to share his/her experience.*
 - 5. To have discussions during Bible class on each prayer focus along with the study on the sanctuary doctrine.*

Prayer Focus

- Day 1 – To commit our lives fully to God and for God to baptize us with the Holy Spirit.
- Day 2 – That we all may be in one accord to continue receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- Day 3 – Confession of sin, deeper repentance that we may experience a fresh baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- Day 4 – To have Christ live in us fully through obedience.
- Day 5 – To have a new heart experience and reflecting Christ.
- Day 6 – To completely yield to the Holy Spirit through confession of sins.
- Day 7 – To experience Bible conversion and be prepared to receive the latter rain of the Spirit.
- Day 8 – To experience a deeper intimate relationship with Christ.
- Day 9 – For God to give us a greater desire to pray more.
- Day 10 – To become prayer warrior as was Jesus and His disciples.
- Day 11 – Pray for the advancement of the gospel and more labourers in the field.
- Day 12 – For God to direct our prayers by the Holy Spirit.
- Day 13 – Uniting and interceding for breakthrough in our lives.
- Day 14 – For God to lead us to learn how to persevere in prayer.
- Day 15 – For God to lead us to become effective prayer intercessors for others.
- Day 16 – To claim God's promises instead of focusing on problems.
- Day 17 – For us to become effective witnesses for Jesus
- Day 18 – To be filled with the Holy Spirit in order to prepare people for the second advent.
- Day 19 – For patience in waiting.

Day 20 – For the church to be filled with the Spirit.

Day 21 – For God to bring us out of our lukewarm state.

Day 22 – For God to bring revival in your life and church.

Day 23 - To pray for lost souls. Each member to meet and pray, interceding for someone.

Day 24 – For every member to practice Christ’s method of evangelism.

Day 25 – To abide in Christ and experience the fullness of His love.

Day 26 – To experience victory over our sins.

Day 27 – To have a deeper revelation of Christ.

Day 28 – To ask God to live out His life in us when tempted.
